The McNaughton Centre-Saving System: Timber isn't cheap. Good, attractive timber is positively expensive. So why do we happily convert most of it into shavings on our workshop floors? Primarily because we believe we have no alternative. That may have been true before the advent of the McNaughton Centre-Saving system but this clever and versatile tool provides a realistic way for you to "core out" blanks from within your turning timber, creating extra material for you to use at no extra cost. Hugely popular with professional turners and recently described as "the turning tool of the century" here's a real opportunity to actually reduce the cost of your hobby. Imagine getting four bowl blanks or even two or three – and why not five or six, out of your source material? Four models of this great tool are available, as follows:-

Kelton Tool Handles: The wide range of specialist woodturning tools developed by New Zealand-based professional woodturner Kel McNaughton share a common basis – the Kelton handle system. Choose from a range of rigid, comfortable, easy-grip handles with a choice of capacities, or the superb **Ultimate Handle** which offers the flexibility to fit just about any interchangeable tool through its ferrule and collet system. (NB: All handles will equally accept imperial or closest metric size tools. i.e. 5/16"=8 mm; 3/8"=10 mm; 1/2"=13 mm; 5/8"=16 mm; 3/4"=20 mm)



Kelton KH1 Handle: (12" overall length, 5/16" and 3/8" tool capacities)

Kelton Hollowers: A range of hollowing tools with various shaft configurations designed to fit into the Kelton Handles (supplied separately). Use of these handles allows the extension of the tool to be regulated to minimise vibration. The tip design ensures quick easy removal of timber through a shearing action, with cuts of up to 20 mm, yet is capable of leaving as surface which is virtually "as sanded". The attention to detail embodied in these tools virtually eliminates the possibility of dig-ins. Easily re-sharpened when necessary, these tools prove that deep hollowing can be both quick and easy.

Kelton Undercutters: Designed to fit Kelton KH3 or KH4 handles (supplied separately) these neat tools are designed to assist in getting into those hard-to-reach places just under the rim of hollow forms or “retrousé” bowl lips. Each set comprises three tools of different radius and form to suit a wide range of situations. Also available is a box cutter for creating the perfect side to base transition in your boxes.

Kelton Undercutter set: (three different profiles, excludes handle) **£76.00 inc VAT**

Kelton Box Cutter: (excludes handle) **£24.50 inc VAT**

Kelton Hook Tool: Designed specifically for use with today’s high speed lathes but based on the well-proven concept of traditional hook tools, this unique tool obviates dig-ins when used correctly. With a shear cutting action it can be used to cut in either an inward or outward direction to leave a fine finish. The 1/2” tip is supplied with a rigid shank (5/8” diameter x 10” long) which fits Kelton KH2, KH3 or KH4 handles (supplied separately).



Kelton 1/2” Hook Tool with large shank: (comprises cutter and long shank, excludes handle) **£36.00 inc VAT**

Kelton Caliper: The ultimate caliper, capable of measuring the wall thickness of almost any part of your hollow form or bowl. Unlike other calipers, this one measures in both an axial direction to assess base thickness as well as radially for wall thickness measurements.

This jig is a really robust, rigid construction yet features easy adjustability to allow any grinding angle to be created and replicated quickly and easily. For those tricky Celtic/O’Donnell/Fingernail etc. grinds, the addition of the Multi-Grind makes creating and maintaining these forms a quick simple job too.
